CJ Ebert

CJ is a Pacific Northwest local. He attended the University of Washington receiving a degree in Anthropology and Art in 1978. CJ built a home on Skagit Bay in La Conner in 2008 and in 2011 became a permanent resident. He has served on the MoNA Board of Trustees for over 10 years during which he has been instrumental in overseeing projects related to MoNA's infrastructure.

CJ is the Owner and Principal of Harbor Mountain Development Company. His areas of expertise include commercial real estate development with an emphasis on land use entitlements and asset management. Some major developments include Biringer Strawberry Farm, a 360 acre wetland mitigation bank now known as the Blue Heron Slough, Port Gardner Landing, a 60,000 square foot mixed-use development on the Everett Waterfront, entitlement and reuse of the former Everett Weyerhaeuser Mill Site and redevelopment of a 140-acre sand and gravel mine for industrial warehouse distribution center. He has been a licensed commercial real estate broker in Washington since 1981.

As a trustee for MoNA, CJ leverages his background and interests in Architecture, Art, Travel, Nature and Music. He recently oversaw the project to repair and replace MoNA's aging HVAC system and roof.
